RECIPE FOR CLASS 66 - Sultana Spice Shortcake

Ingredients

145 gm butter 145 gm soft brown sugar 1 tablespoon golden syrup 1 egg

1 1/2 tsp vanilla extract 260 gm plain flour 1 tsp baking powder 120 gm sultanas

Icing

75 gm icing sugar 50 gm butter 2 tsp caster sugar 1 tsp ground ginger or 1 tsp cinnamon

Oven 190 C Fan oven 170 C Gas 5 1 tray bake tin = 24 cm x 24 cm approx., greased and lined

Method

- 1. Melt butter, sugar, syrup and sultanas together over a low heat and allow to cool.
- 2. Beat the egg and vanilla extract together and add to the saucepan.
- 3. Sieve the flour and baking powder, stir into the mixture and mix well.
- 4. Pour into prepared tin and bake for 20 minutes. Be careful not to over bake.
- 5. Towards the end of the baking time make the icing. Gently melt butter in saucepan and stir in other ingredients.
- 6. Drizzle icing over cake immediately then leave to cool completely before removing from tin.
- 7. Cut into squares.

75 grams butter or margarine 40 grams soft brown sugar 60 grams golden syrup 90 grams plain flour 1/2 teaspoon baking powder 1/4 teaspoon bicarbonate of soda 1 egg 60mls milk

- 1 1lb loaf tin approx. 20cm x 10cm, greased and lined. Oven 160°C, Gas 3
 - Melt butter or margarine with sugar and syrup in saucepan over a low heat and allow to cool.
 - 2. Mix together milk and egg and add to saucepan beating well.
 - Sieve flour, baking powder and bicarbonate of soda together and add to mixture in saucepan.
 - 4. Mix well and pour into tin.
 - 5. Bake for 40 minutes until firm to the touch. Allow cake to cool in tin.
 - 6. Tip: to keep the moisture in, a tin foil hat can be placed on the top to allow steam to go back into the cake..


